## **RESUME PROFILE**

Paolo Fusero was born in Genoa in 1960. After graduating in Architecture (1986) with the highest marks, he obtained the title of PhD in urban planning at La Sapienza University of Rome and the G. d' Annunzio of Chieti-Pescara (1994). He was visiting scholar at Tonji University in Shanghai (1991) and visiting PhD student at Waterloo University in Toronto (1994).

After graduating, he began his collaboration with Bruno Gabrielli for a decade. Among his most significant professional experiences of that period are: the PRG of Piacenza (1992), Pisa (1993), Paternò (1995), Parma (1996), the PTC of Ragusa (1997), and various projects and consultancies throughout the national territory.

He adds to the experience gained as an urban planner that of City Manager (1996-98), gained within the Public Administration as Senior Manager of the Technical Sector of the Municipality of Parma.

After an intense professional activity, in 2000 he took up service at the G. d'Annunzio University of Chieti, Faculty of Architecture, winning the following competitions in the Academic Discipline of Urban Planning and Landscape (ICAR/21): Researcher (2000), Associate Professor (2006) and Full Professor (2010). He has written about ten books and curatorships to his credit, as well as about a hundred scientific publications in volumes and sector magazines that mainly focus on issues such as: innovation of urban planning tools on an urban and territorial scale, smart cities and environmental projects with particular attention to climate change phenomenon.

Since 2012 he has participated in European Programs related to environmental planning, urban regeneration and climate change. He won competitions for management roles in local units of European Projects: Project Manager (2013), Capacity Building Manager (2020).

He was a member of the Board of Directors of the Italian Society of Planners-SIU (2007-2011). He has held important governance positions at the G. d'Annunzio University, including: member of the Organizing Technical Committee of the Leonardo da Vinci Telematic University (2004-2009), member of the Ud'A Board of Directors (2006-2011), Vice-Dean of the Faculty of Architecture (2004-2011), Academic Senator Ud'A (2013-18), Director of the Department of Architecture (2014-2020). Since 2020 is member of the Board of Directors of Ud'A.
